New Business

Alfred

-Wool Cup currently has 31 registrations, including 10 SASA teams and 21 competitive or academy teams. The upfront payment requirement has been removed for local teams, and if registration numbers remain low by Friday, the registrar may extend registration for local teams as needed. Rosters are due on the 9th, with the possibility of an extension if necessary; however, additional registrations are still needed. Recreational teams

U7 and older may request to play in academy or competitive divisions by contacting the registrar. All teams are encouraged to participate despite other community events taking place.

-Guest players may be used only to bring a team up to its maximum roster size; teams may not carry a full roster and add guest players beyond the maximum limit.

-Field Day is scheduled for this Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and the office staff will send an email requesting coach involvement.

-The main water line has broken next to the southside concession stand, affecting the women's restroom, and repairs are currently underway.

-Board members may be asked to assist with refereeing during the Wool Cup on Friday.

-Locks will be installed on the referee room restrooms.

Sarah

-2025 Financial Report will be ready by the end of February.

-W-2 and W-9 forms have been distributed, and required forms will also be available at the first game.

-Referees will not be paid until their W-9 forms are completed and submitted. All referees are required to fill out and sign a W-9, even minors.

-For transparency purposes, financial reports will be posted quarterly.

Jessica

-Beginning in the fall season, the league will transition from a birth-year registration format to a school-year format required by NTX.

-An update was also provided regarding the U10 girls team that was disbanded. When the board makes the decision to disband a team, there is a valid reason for doing so. During team formation, the registrar identified that there were only nine players on each U10 girls team, which competes in a 7v7 format with a maximum roster size of 12. The coach of the affected team was not returning, while the other teams' coaches were committed to returning. To ensure competitive balance and roster stability, the team was disbanded and the players were redistributed accordingly. Parents were not required to be notified of this administrative decision. A parent attended the AGM expressing interest in coaching the team; however, this was unknown to the registrar at the time of restructuring. NTX reviewed the situation and confirmed that SASA followed all appropriate procedures. Ultimately, 15 players did not return in that age division. It was also noted that there was a communication disconnect between the Coaches Representative and the Registrar due to the Coaches Representative position being vacant at the time.
