On Going Business

-Open positions (u910 Girls, Vice President, Field Director)-Johnny Taborda expressed interest in the commissioner position and is expected to submit a letter of intent soon.

New Business

Alfred

-Stormie Tournament-tournament proposal reviewed, with concerns raised about the short timeframe, the possibility of overloading the schedule with three tournaments in five months, and the risk of drawing attention away from already scheduled events. Alternatives were considered, including offering discounts for participating in multiple tournaments, shifting the event to a more relaxed and fun format rather than highly competitive play, or postponing it until next year, potentially in July as a one-day event to allow for better planning and promotion. It was also suggested to send representatives to nearby organizational meetings to help with advertising and possibly align the event with spring break when many teams are already traveling. It was decided to postpone the tournament until next year.

-Saturday Clean Up- golf carts will be assigned to board members based on availability, and they will no longer need to remain stationed at games. Availability sheets will be distributed through GroupMe for coordination. Board members were reminded of the importance of always carrying and responding to radios, particularly when situations arise in their designated areas. When multiple board members are affiliated with a team, at least one must remain available in an official capacity rather than acting solely as a coach or parent. It was noted that Aaron, serving as A&D, may step away from situations to remain as unbiased as possible and should only be approached for general questions.

-Sibling Request- Procedures regarding age group inquiries were clarified, with registration questions directed to the registrar and age-specific concerns routed to the appropriate commissioner.

-Fall 2026 Coach's Intent Form- The coach intent form process was discussed, emphasizing efforts to keep teams together when possible while still adhering to the age chart. Board members were encouraged to consult with Jessica to ensure accurate information is provided, and coach and parent emails were scheduled to be sent out that evening. Sibling requests will be handled during the special request meeting.

-Board members were also reminded to communicate respectfully and to continue following proper procedures for rescheduling.

-Spanish speaking option on coach registration to better support non-English-speaking players, and the opening of a line of credit to assist during periods of low funds.

-A processing fee will now be added to all registration plans to help generate income.

-Discussed and decided to discontinue U4 shirts due to low pickup rates and noted the need to organize and sort medals. Concerns were raised about field tampering, including moved goals, damaged nets, and a removed plaque.

-The board discussed the possibility of using a third party for the open house but ultimately voted against it, citing concerns about potential interference with existing setups, vendors, and revenue. The open house will continue to focus on publicity, exposure, and providing general information. The final vote was 7 against and 0 in favor of using a third party.

-The board will assist KB Apparel with a drawing for 12 sublimated jerseys at either the open house or a coaches meeting.

-Plans were also introduced to host a public forum once a month to address community questions, with board meetings being posted online and open to the public. The meeting concluded with a 10-minute public comment period, during which no comments were made.

Jessica (Email update)

-Commissioners can continue to send reschedule requests, and the schedule will be updated accordingly by assigning a field. If teams want to play a double header on another Saturday, that can be done as well.

-Currently we have 147 Registrations for Fall 2026. Early Bird Registration goes through May 15th and scholarship deadline is May 15th as well
