- Complaint Procedure- **all complaints will need to go straight to the President; he will then determine if they need to be escalated to A&D. If escalated, A&D will form a committee and will take over the complaint. presidnet@soccersanangelo.org**
- Reschedule Policy- **went over new rescheduling policy, we will now use blackout dates that must be submitted by Aug 11th. Schedules will be released on Aug 15th. Any rescheduling request made after the deadline will only be considered for extenuating circumstances. Those will need to be submitted to the commissioner and the commissioner will then relay it to the registrar who will provide 2 dates for the coaches to choose from. Double headers are unavoidable if you request a reschedule. Rescheduling requests will only be accepted if ALL requirements are completed. In the case of bad weather where we must reschedule, games may run into November, but that will be used as a last resort. All communications with commissioners need to be in writing (text, email, GroupMe, etc.) As a reminder, coaches are not allowed to contact players who are not on their roster, that is considered recruiting. Colors on rosters are to be abide by as teams primary color.**
- Coaches' Clinic (August 11th U4-U6 6pm- 7pm & U7 & up 7pm-8pm)- **held by Gabe Castro, sign up will be available on SASA website next week**
- Virtual Coach IDs (need passport style pictures & requirements completion) **-refs will be checking virtual ids at the start of every game. Coaches are able to screenshot id for easy access. Board members and refs will be doing random roster checks. Pictures need to be passport style and recent. A game will not start unless virtual badge is shown.**
- Player's Profiles (need passport style pictures) **pictures need to be updated and passport style**
- Coaches Needed
- Referees needed **-SASA will reimburse \$40 of the \$80 total to anyone who signs up to ref and completed their first day. All board members will now be ref and coach certified to be able to step in at any time if needed in an emergency. There is a ref shortage, so in the event of not having enough refs available, refs will be pulled starting at the youngest age group and a parent/coach may have to step in.**

-Referee Complaint Procedure- SASA will be enforcing our 0-tolerance policy for ref abuse. All complaints will be sent directly to NTX and if the complaint is with a minor ref, the penalties will be 3x enforced.
