Alfred

-A review of North Texas Soccer (NTX) rules confirmed that players registered as competitive are not permitted to participate in recreational leagues. An overview of related email correspondence from NTX and documentation of impacted players was presented and discussed.

-The Registrar and office staff reviewed and checked all players in the divisions of U10 and up.

-Discussion regarding the removal of ineligible players and the next steps for affected teams. Mesiah's mother visited the office, reporting that additional players are allegedly participating in both competitive and recreational play. All four identified players are members of the same competitive team. Both teams involved are currently in contention for top standings, potentially finishing in the top two.

-It was reported that Team Fuego may have added a new player during the past weekend who is not registered with SASA. The importance of conducting roster checks was emphasized. All teams must comply with NTX and SASA rules.

-NTX is currently managing any disciplinary action related to coaching violations. However, SASA must determine appropriate actions for the teams involved. The board agreed to uphold all NTX and SASA rules and take a firm stance on enforcement. A decision must be made regarding consequences for the teams and players involved.

Motion:

Team Fuego and Team Red may continue to play without the ineligible competitive players. However, they must forfeit all previously played games and corresponding points.

Additional terms:

- Teams may continue participation for the remainder of the season if they choose.
- Teams choosing to forfeit are still responsible for paying referee fees.
- Neither team will be eligible for awards or participation in the Tournament of Champions (TOC).
