- -Wool Cup: Tournament advertised on NTX Website. Flyer created and ready for distribution. Open to Rec, Competitive, and Academy teams. Registration opens November 10th. This will be a Sanctioned tournament — all board members must be present February 20th. Must handle scoring carefully; A&D required and all documentation filed properly. Alfred to prepare budget for next meeting.
- -Surrounding Areas / Outreach: Need to find ways to reach potential players in nearby communities. Discussed options on purchasing mailing addresses or contact school districts. Start outreach early to ensure exposure. Establish a radius policy for San Angelo-based teams (players within radius play on local teams). Players outside radius can join similar teams elsewhere. Advertising and wording must be specific and clear to avoid team stacking. Target areas: Eldorado, Miles, Carlsbad, Grape Creek, Sonora, Wall, Brady — focusing primarily on Tom Green County.
- -SASA Players: May join any academy team and can be contacted after the season ends. SASA players cannot be contacted until new rosters are formed.
- -Need to promote upcoming dine-out fundraiser dates.
